

Steps to Manually Migrate from GoDaddy to Microsoft 365





Move GoDaddy Mailbox using Microsoft Outlook to Microsoft 365


We must set up Microsoft Outlook to use the GoDaddy email account. The steps to set up GoDaddy email in Microsoft Outlook are listed below.

Step 1: Open Outlook on your desktop or laptop.


Step 2: Now select **Add account** from the **File** menu by clicking the icon.



- **Step 3:** On the **Connect** screen, enter your GoDaddy **email address**.
- **Step 4:** Enter your GoDaddy email account password.
- **Step 5:** Click the **Connect** button once you've entered the password.




The successfully added account status is shown here.




You have now configured Outlook to connect to your GoDaddy email. Now you must export the email into an Outlook PST file format.

Steps to export the GoDaddy PST file:


- Step 1: Launch the version of Outlook that is linked to your GoDaddy account.
- **Step 2:** Navigate to **Open & Export** from the **File** menu and click on **Open**.
- Step 3: Then select Import/Export from the menu.
- **Step 4:** There is now an import/export wizard accessible. Select "**Export to a file**" and then click "**Next**."
- Step 5: Then, select Outlook data file (.pst) as the export file type and click "Next".
- **Step 6:** Locate the configured GoDaddy email account by scrolling down the page. Check the Include subdirectory box and choose the **GoDaddy email address**. Click **Next**.



Step 7: To choose the saving path, click the **Browse** button. Additionally, choose one option from the available options.



Step 8: To save the GoDaddy emails to PST formats, press the **Finish** button.




Uploading a PST file into Microsoft 365 using Outlook

Clicking the Finish button will ensure GoDaddy emails are exported into PST and Outlook data file formats. Finally, the migration of GoDaddy emails to Microsoft 365 needs to be completed by uploading a PST file into the platform.


- Step 1: Open Microsoft Outlook.
- Step 2: Select File from the menu.

Step 3: Next, click the Open & Export button.



Step 4: Once you click on the Open & Export button, a wizard for **Import and Export** will appear. Select **Import from another program or file** option.

Step 5: Select **Outlook Data File** (.pst) and then click the **Next** button.



Step 6: Choose the pst File of your preference.

Step 7: Finally, click on the Finish button to upload the .pst file into Office.
